### Day 1: Flight to Portland

Fly to Portland, Oregon, "City of Roses". Today meet your Tour Director and transfer to your hotel for a leisurely five-night stay. Portland features a collection of gardens, world class museums, historic districts along with acres of parks typical of the Pacific Northwest. Tonight enjoy a **Welcome Dinner** to get acquainted with your fellow passengers. Meal: (D)

### Day 2: Portland Sightseeing - Mt. St. Helens

After breakfast enjoy a **Portland City Tour** featuring **Washington Park** with its famous **International Rose Test Garden** and a visit to the **Pittock Mansion**, nestled high on a hill above the city skyline the historic mansion is a symbol of Portland from small lumber town to bustling city. This afternoon visit **Mt. St. Helens Volcanic National Monument**. On May 18, 1980, Mount St. Helens erupted. Shaken by an earthquake measuring 5.1 on the Richter scale, the north face of this tall symmetrical mountain collapsed in a massive rock debris avalanche. Also visit the **Johnston Ridge Observatory** located within the blast site of the eruption offering spectacular views of the mountain. The observatory features a film about the eruption, exhibits and an unobstructed viewing plaza. Meals: (B,D)

### Day 3: Portland Rose Festival

Today experience the **Portland Rose Festival**, the second largest all-floral parade in North America and the single-largest spectator event in Oregon. This afternoon enjoy lunch on your own at the **Saturday Market**. The rest of the day is at your leisure: wander along the waterfront or through a park, visit a downtown museum or enjoy a book in a Portland coffee house. Meal: (B)

### Day 4: Astoria - Oregon Coast

This morning travel to **Astoria**, the northernmost city in Oregon situated where the Columbia River meets the Pacific Ocean. The city features the famous 4.1 mile Astoria Bridge and many historic homes. Visit **Fort Clatsop National Memorial**, commemorating the 1805-06 winter encampment of the 33-member Lewis and Clark Expedition. Then travel along Oregon's scenic Pacific Coast through **Rockaway & Cannon State Beaches**. Later visit the **Tillamook Cheese Factory** for a tasty tour. Then return to your hotel in Portland. Meal: (B)

### Day 5: Multnomah Falls - Columbia Gorge Cruise - Winery Visit

This morning travel east and stop at **Multnomah Falls**, the second highest year-round waterfall in the nation. Then experience the history of the Columbia River Gorge and learn about the Lewis and Clark Expedition on a cruise aboard the **Sternwheeler Columbia Gorge**, an authentic triple-deck paddle wheeler, providing breathtaking vistas. Also see the **Bonneville Dam**, part of a dam system which produces power and creates a 465-mile navigable waterway. Later enjoy a **Winery Visit & Tasting** to sample a few of the varieties produced in this region. Return to Portland this afternoon. This evening enjoy a **Farewell Dinner** at a popular local restaurant with your travelling companions. Meals: (B,D)

### Day 6: Portland - Return Home

Today transfer to the airport for your flight home filled with wonderful memories of your **Oregon Trails Tour**. Meal: (B)
